Grading System

Starting with the 2000 - 2001 school year the grading system will be by contract (see forms). As of 2007-2008 grades will be determined by the DCSD "Power School" program and are available on-line. The Jazz Band contract will deal with students in 0 period Jazz Band. Playing tests and a possible final exam will also affect semester grades.

GRADES...

Class Attendance... given every 3 weeks during the 2nd semester only (there are enough grades during the marching season [1st semester] that this grade is not used) (however it is used for Jazz Band)

50 points possible... -5 points excused absence, -10 pts. unexcused absence, -3 pts. tardy, -5pts. behavior issues (each occurrence), -5 pts. no instrument. (You may do a "make-up" assignment for excused absences and tardies within one week of the tardy or absence)

50 points possible... Mandatory rehearsals (not during school hours)

100 points possible... Performance grades & test grades.

200 points possible... Winter & Spring concerts. *(part of the grade includes setting-up and putting things away)* Starting with the 2011-2012 school year you will either need to "set-up" or "tear-down". If you do both, you will get extra credit.

Unexcused absences ... An unexcused absence will be recorded up to 75% only if a make-up assignment is completed (If a make-up assignment is not received with-in a one week period the grade will be recorded as an unexcused absence.)

An excused absence will be recorded up to 100% only if a make-up assignment is completed (If a make-up assignment is not received with-in a one week period the grade will be recorded as a zero.)

DHS Sports (club sports are not a DHS sport) absence will be recorded at 90%. (or you may choose to do a make-up assignment for full credit).

Points will be lowered from 100 for tardies, behavior problems, not following the rules, unclean uniform / shoes, etc. Of course freshman / 8th graders will not be given marching band grades and must earn a minimum 90% of all rehearsals / performances in order to travel with the band.

INELIGIBILITY... You will be permitted to make-up the points of the "assignment" you were ineligible to attend at a maximum of 75% ... You will need to complete the make-up work with-in one week of the missed performance / rehearsal.

All "make-up" assignments will be assigned by the director ...Forms will be on-line at www.douglasmusic.net

Participation in DHS sports and other DHS extra-curricular activities...will NOT lower your **letter grade!** However, the following is expected:

- Notification a minimum of **2 weeks** prior to the event.
- Band rehearsal takes precedent over sports practice. (see the director)
- Band performance takes precedent over sports practice
- YOU WILL NOT NEED TO DO A MAKE-UP ASSIGNMENT FOR YOUR 90% GRADE!**

Other pertinent information...

- All rehearsals & performances are mandatory! This would include practice for the flag team after school.
- Forms will be on-line at www.douglasmusic.net (The director will not give you these forms)**
- All performances are important. However, some performances are extremely important! Such as: Concerts, festivals, contests, parades! *As of 5/2010 a new excuse form will be in effect... you must do an alternative assignment if you are to be excused!*
- Failure to have your instrument (flag, etc.) will lower your grade.
- Fifth year seniors (students repeating their senior year) will **not** be able to participate in the band due to NIAA (Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association) eligibility requirements.
- "Attitude" problems (talking, not paying attention, gum, etc.) will lower your conduct grade and lower your semester grade!
- Not being properly attired for a performance (dirty shoes, no white socks, forgetting part of your uniform, etc. will lower your semester grade (other consequences may apply).
- Auditioning for Honor band, Allstate, and performing in Solo & Ensemble festivals will have a positive impact on your grade.
- Please remember... we are a band! You are important! Your attendance is very important! Sometimes things happen where it is impossible to be at 2 places at once. Please try to be considerate of all of the hard work you and the rest of the band have put in and how your absence would affect the band! Work schedules can be changed... **therefore working will be considered an unexcused absence!**
- A good "rule of thumb" is **NO SURPRISES!** You will be informed of all rehearsals and performances as soon as they are known. **I want to be informed of all possible absences as soon as you know about them... NO SURPRISES!** (Please see bullet #2 above) I have been directing the DHS Band for over 25 years... I have not bitten anyone (yet)! Talk to me personally about problems or situations before they escalate!
- Grading will also be done by the stipulations of your signed contract!**

Individual Awards Program

- ◆ LETTER... To be awarded at the beginning of the student's 2nd year in the DHS Band (to be presented at the annual "Marching Pizza Party")
- ◆ HOODED SWEATSHIRT... To be awarded at the beginning of the student's senior year in the DHS Band (Must have been at least three years in the band with the Senior year counting as the 3rd) (usually to be awarded in October)
- ◆ ALL AWARDS are contingent upon the student maintaining a minimum "B" average in band. Students not maintaining this minimum average, will delay their award for a minimum of one complete semester. The student will receive their award ONLY IF they have received a "B+" or better average for the probationary semester.
- ◆ WITH THE ADDITION OF 8TH GRADE band members students may be awarded a letter during their freshman year!
- ◆ **If a student does not represent the department in a professional manner, NO awards shall be issued!**
- ◆ **THE FINAL DECISION DETERMINING AWARD(S) SHALL BE MADE BY THE DIRECTOR!**

Band Performances

We practice to perform! The following is a synopsis of our performances: (ALL PERFORMANCES ARE MANDATORY)

Marching Performances

- ◆ Football Games... We perform at all home varsity games and we may perform at any playoff game.
 - A. Use the restroom before inspection... NO restroom use will be permitted before half-time!
 1. Possible Inspection (this will affect your grade!)
 2. March out to the field.
 3. Play "Pregame" (songs and National Anthem)
 4. March to seats **NON-BAND MEMBERS MAY NOT SIT WITH THE BAND!... NO CELLPHONES!!**
 5. **Be ready to play** when situations warrant (touchdown, quarter, etc.).
 6. HALF-TIME... FIELDSHOW
 7. March back to seats. Restroom use **may** take place (2 boys / 2 girls at a time)
 8. We shall exit at the **end of the game, ONLY**, by parading out of the stadium all the way back to the band room.
- ◆ **"RULE 9"**. *You will be dismissed after all uniforms are properly hung-up, room and restroom are cleaned, after a "few words". EVERYBODY has places to go! The faster this is done the faster we all get to leave. Leaving early will be cause to lower your conduct grade, semester grade, and revoke your travel privileges PERIOD!*
- ◆ **Field Show Competitions...** (McQueen, Galena, Damonte Ranch, UNR, Las Vegas, etc.)
 1. Usually takes place on Saturdays in October (See current year's marching schedule)
 2. Just as the name implies... this is a competition! **We must be our best!**
- ◆ **Parades...** Needless to say, in the past decade we have been the **"BEST PARADE BAND IN THE STATE OF NEVADA"**
 1. Parades you can expect to be marching in:
 - A. Nevada Day
 - B. Parade of Lights
 2. Parades we may march in:
 - A. Director's Discretion
- ◆ *Inspection may take place at the competition or before the parade!*

As Always, "Rule 9" from above applies after every performance or rehearsal!

Concert Performances

◆ Winter Concert (Thursday, December 15, 2011)

1. Usually held before Christmas Vacation
2. Combined with the DHS Choirs
3. Held in the DHS "Auditorium" (commons) [You must either help "set-up" or "tear-down"]
4. Inspection is usually held before the concert.
5. Refreshments are served... every performer is required to bring a dozen (12) cookies.

◆ Spring Concert (Thursday, May 17, 2012)

1. Usually held in May.
2. NOT combined with the choirs.
3. See Winter Concert

◆ Concert Festivals

NZNMEA - Northern Zone Nevada Music Educators Association

1. Held in various locations in early Spring, during the school day.
2. An adjudicated festival but NOT a competition.

UNR Festival (Possible...)

1. This is a competition
2. Usually held late April early May

◆ Other Concert Performances

Annual Elementary "Whirlwind Tour" (27th Annual - TBA - May)

1. We will perform at all 6 valley elementary schools. (Groups TBA)
2. Schedule... TBA
3. Mandatory (AS PER BAND POLICY, EACH SCHOOL COUNTS AS ONE PERFORMANCE)

Annual Elementary 19th Annual "Holiday Breeze" Tour (December 2011 - TBA)

1. May be performed this year during December. (Jazz Band & Madrigal Singers)

Music in the Parks

1. Festival usually in March, April or May (must get a Superior rating at the NZNMEA Festival to be eligible).
2. Mandatory (a liberal excuse policy will be enforced)

Any concert performance deemed necessary by the director

1. Advanced notice will be given
2. Mandatory

◆ "Pep band" Performances

Basketball Games

1. Jazz Band responsibility
2. Girls games and boys games... schedule TBA
3. Possible Play-off games

Pep Assemblies

1. Usually complete band during football season. (jazz band is possible... director's discretion)
2. Various time during the year (school day)
3. "Bon-Fire" evening during football homecoming week
4. Director's discretion on "uniform"

◆ Generally Speaking...

1. We use the "prance/strut" step when we march.
2. Our step size is generally 22.5" or 8 steps for every 5 yards (8 to 5)
3. We guide to the center during parades.
4. Parade line-up & field show line-up are different.
5. We line-up 5 or 7 across (director's discretion)
6. Band block from front to rear...

See chart to right...

Majorette(s) (optional)
 Banner Carriers / ID Unit
 Drum Major
 Trumpets / Trombones
 Low Brass / other brass
Percussion (option "A")
 Saxes
 Clarinets
 Flutes / Piccolo
Percussion (option "B")

Transportation... MUST BE BY SCHOOL BUS (VEHICLE)

1. Exceptions may be made by the principal and director in very rare and special circumstances.
2. **ONLY** the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) may pick-up band members if:
 - A. The band member previously gives the director a written note from the parent / legal guardian.
 - B. The parent / legal guardian gets in touch with the band director immediately after the performance. The parent / legal guardian must then complete an official release form.
 - C. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Of Course, All Performances are MANDATORY! However, should and excuse become necessary...

1. Excuse forms must be followed (see form "A")
2. Starting with the 2000 - 2001 school year and continuing this year, excuses **shall NOT be approved if an "excused absence request form" is not submitted in a timely fashion (see forms)**
3. In order for the excuse to be valid, a mandatory alternative assignment must be turned in within one (1) week of the missed activity. If this is not done, the activity missed will be marked as unexcused.

Trips

Part of the fun in band is taking trips! The Band shall take at least one (1) overnight trip per school year if funds are available from student / parent fundraising.

1. When the band is taking an overnight trip, the proper forms must be given to the director a minimum of **2 DAYS BEFORE THE TRIP! NO SLIP... NO TRIP!** (Usually, bus seating will be determined by order of slips received!)
2. Please be aware of the eligibility requirements (no "F"s).
3. You will not only be representing yourself, but your school, and community. **A trip is a privilege, not a right!**
4. **ALL SCHOOL RULES APPLY ON ALL SCHOOL SANCTIONED TRIPS!**
5. **Breaking of the rules may result in the loss of your trip privileges with any music group for your tenure at DHS.**

Jazz Band

1. Members of the Jazz Band **MUST** be enrolled in band. Exceptions **MAY** be the rhythm section, and vocalist. The vocalist does not necessarily need to be enrolled in the 0 Period Jazz band class. Exceptions shall be granted **ONLY** by the director, and only with his approval!
2. Director's approval and / or auditions shall determine membership in the Jazz Band.
3. Grades shall be attendance and performance based (see contract)
4. Jazz band uniforms shall be determined by the director and must be worn at every performance.
5. Performances shall be "booked" by the director and may be canceled by the director. Performances shall include but not be limited to: Concerts, Festivals, Basketball games, etc.
6. Performances will **try** to be scheduled with a 2 week minimum notification.
7. **The director of the Jazz Band solely determines the performance schedule and personnel of the group. The director may choose not to include any student in the class for any reason. The director may choose to schedule or not to schedule a performance, and is solely responsible for any cancellation or rescheduling of such performances.**
8. With the approval of the administration, occasionally 0 Period class may be canceled.

Classroom Expectations

Our rehearsal time is valuable, therefore:

1. **You must be ready to play immediately after the tardy bell. No exceptions!**
2. Talking or gum chewing will not be tolerated.
3. Reeds, valve oil, etc. may be available before or after class (or rehearsal)...**NOT DURING!**
4. Hall passes will not be issued. (extreme emergencies will be considered)
5. Excuses will not be tolerated for: Not marching, not playing, etc. Written notes only and only **BEFORE** class.
6. All School rules apply.
7. **Food, gum and sodas are not permitted in the band room (field, street, etc.) during class time... Your grade will be lowered and the food will be disposed. (8/2005)**

Leadership Team

This will take place in lieu of the former “band council”. This “team” has evolved over the last few seasons with good results. marching section leaders will selected by the band director and drum major. The marching season leadership team will consist of : the director, flag advisor, drum major, assistant drum major(s)/librarian, and section leaders. Responsibilities will go from helping to place people in the field show, taking roll, and other duties as assigned by the director. During concert season, section leaders will be the principal players of their section, the drum major and director.

Uniforms

Marching... Hat, gloves (white), coat, overlay, pants, **white socks**, approved band shoes, and suspenders (band members will be responsible for supplying their own shoes, gloves, and socks. Shoe & glove orders will take place during the 1st rehearsals of the band. *OR starting with the 2010 marching season “Field Show Uniforms” (baseball cap, vest, warm-up pants, white long sleeve t-shirt, white marching shoes)* **Students will be required to purchase shoes, hats & t-shirts.**

Concert... Coat, dickey, bow-tie, pants (no skirts except drum major), white socks, approved band shoes.

Pep Band... Music Dept. T-shirt and blue jeans (T-shirt \$ TBA)

Jazz Band... Concert band uniforms or dress clothes or pep band uniform (Director’s decision)

All Music groups will be required to purchase a NEW Music department T-shirt (hat or visor are optional) (this started with the 97-98 school year). Price-\$20.00 (\$10.00 for hat or visor)

Shoes \$35.00 (\$30.00 if prepaid) Gloves \$5.00 (\$3.00 if prepaid)

Each Traditional Band uniform costs over \$600.00 to replace, therefore:

1. NO eating or drinking while in uniform. Under garments (including shirts) **MUST** be worn.
2. Uniforms, once on for the performance may not be removed (partially or completely) during that performance (football games, etc.). **Grades will be lowered or other consequences will be incurred!**
3. Hang uniforms in your assigned bags neatly in your assigned area.
4. **Absolutely NO SHOES in the GARMENT BAGS!! (\$12.00 charge for a damaged bag)**
5. Uniforms are dry cleaned 2 times per year. If your uniform is not where it is supposed to be (school uniform room), you will pay to have it cleaned!
6. The “best fitting” uniform will be made available to you. If need be the uniform will be altered to fit you.
7. Uniforms are not to go home unless special permission is granted from the **DIRECTOR ONLY!**
8. Dickeys and bow ties will be issued at the appropriate times.

Drum Major... The Drum Major must be an upper classman (Junior or Senior) A perspective DM or assistant DM must complete the DM application. The date of DM auditions is usually held in early June. The date for completed applications will be made available at least 2 weeks in advance of the auditions. Auditions shall consist of:

1. A successful completion of the application.
2. Be responsible for all or part of the following: Commands, routine/directing parade band, 32 count salute.
3. If successful with the above, candidates will be invited to an after school audition consisting of: Routine (40%), Interview (50%), 16 count salute (10%) in front of a 2-3 professional judges.
4. The successful candidate will need to complete the Drum Major contract, attend Drum Major Camp (paid for by the music boosters) Candidates will need to provide their own transportation to and from camp.
5. The Drum Major is required to assist the band director on the street and on the field.
6. Band members are expected to listen to the DM just as they would the director. If a band member believes the DM is being vindictive, etc. they should immediately discuss this with the director.

Honors Programs

Honor Band (February 1 & 2, 2012)

1. Selected by a taped audition made in early November.
2. Held during school time (usually January/February) therefore one must maintain DHS eligibility requirements.
3. You must be a member of the band in good standing (“A” grade, little or no absences / tardies. No “N”s or “U”s).
4. All fees are paid by the DCSD Music Budget... but must be reimbursed if the student is accepted but does not attend.

Allstate Band (April 18-21, 2012).... “Small State” in Battle Mountain April 26-28, 2012

1. See Honor Band
2. Must have performed in the honor band concert to be eligible to perform in the Allstate band.
3. 2012 Site – Las Vegas
4. The DCSD Music Budget provides money for the fees, transportation and lodging. (food \$ is not provided)
5. Students must pay their own audition fee
5. All fees must be reimbursed if a student does not participate. Also, the NMEA will prohibit you from participating in the future.

1. The DCSD Music Budget pays all fees, which must be reimbursed if the student does not participate.
2. The student(s) must have received a superior rating (“I+”, “I”, “I-”) the NZNMEA festival in order to be eligible to participate at the Allstate Festival Zone Festival (When there are 2 festivals). **The director will have the final authority in determining whether the student or group shall participate at the Allstate festival.**
3. The performer(s) MUST provide their own accompanist.
4. Freshman may be eligible to participate in the Allstate Solo & Ensemble festival ONLY when this festival is in RENO or if they have been selected to an Allstate ensemble.

Please note the eligibility contract! All dates will be made known as soon as they are available!

Music Booster Organization... The primary function is to help support the DHS Music Department

1. Holding meetings to discuss music and fundraising functions. 10-11 meetings will be held on the first Wednesdays.
2. Chaperons... required by the DCSD on ALL trips. (Decision of the director is final)
3. For more information please contact **TBA (See the website for more info).**
4. The boosters are responsible for helping to or purchasing the Band Uniforms, Silver Plated Sousaphones, Bari Sax, Flag Uniforms, Madrigal Costumes, Choir Robes, Image Costumes... just to name a few!!!

Instruments

Some instruments are available for your use.

1. Instrument forms (contracts) MUST BE SIGNED and given to the director if you are using a school instrument. Over \$1000.00 was spent on repairs last year for the instruments and **over \$8000.00 the last few years!** Therefore if your instrument (school owned) breaks you will need to get it repaired or replaced!
2. Reeds, valve oil, etc. may be available for a nominal fee... NO CREDIT will be extended.

Fund Raising

1. This is an essential activity if we are to take overnight trips. Dates will be assigned by the school for us to sell candy, etc. It is the responsibility of everyone to **“Do your share”!** During the past few years we have had very successful “Adopt-A-Band-Member” campaigns. We will continue to keep you informed on all of our fund raising activities!

Band Auxiliary (“Pageantry”)... Vital to the marching band; they shall be considered as part of the marching band, and shall be graded as such!

1. See sample contract
2. All units shall be coordinated by the **band director**, who shall have the **final say** on uniforms, routines, practices, etc.
3. Units shall have an advisor who will work closely with the director.
4. Units for the field show shall include the Flag Team and may include the Dance Line and Drill Team.
5. Units for the parades shall include Banner (or letter) Carriers (ID Unit) and Flag Team. Also, it may include majorette(s), Dance Line & Drill Team. *The Dance Line and Drill Team may participate in parades only if they consent to being part of the “Fieldshow Team”.*
6. Judges for tryouts of the Flag Team shall include the Band Director and Flag Advisor. Tryouts shall be held in the Spring (May or June).
7. Banner / Letter carriers (ID Unit) and majorette(s) ***shall be selected by the Director & Pageantry Director only!***
8. Captain(s) (if deemed necessary) shall be selected by the advisor and the director.
9. Flag Team members (10-12) MUST be enrolled in band class for at least the Fall semester.
10. Flag team members who are not enrolled in band during the 2nd semester will be invited to participate in any marching trips. Flag team members who are enrolled in band for the spring semester are encouraged to play an instrument.

Concert Season Chair Placement... Shall depend on the results of a playing test (this test shall be graded in the manner of the playing final).

1. Chromatic scale ascending - tongued descending - slurred
2. Audition piece
3. *Sight reading (May be included)*
4. The audition will be recorded in the band “taping” room. Someone will be in the room to assist you and to operate the tape recorder. **ONCE AGAIN... you will be graded on your efforts!**

1. The challenger must let the director and the challengee know of the challenge 1 week in advance. The director will inform the contestants as to the piece(s) they will be playing.
2. Challenges shall take place in the director's "work room" during lunch only on **Tuesdays** (The international day of challenges). The challengers will not be seen during the challenge.
3. An Ad Hoc committee of interested band members along with the director shall be the judges. ***The director's decision shall be final.*** The winner of the challenge may only be challenged again 2 weeks in a row. If the challenger (lower chair) wins, the challenged (upper chair) may challenge in (1) one week, after which there will be a moratorium on that particular challenge for a minimum of (3) three weeks. If the challenge is unsuccessful (lower chair does not win) there will be a moratorium on that particular challenge for a minimum of (3) three weeks.
4. Challenges will use the following procedure, alternating between players: chromatic scale (2 octaves), piece #1, piece #2, (piece #3). **CHALLENGERS WILL IN NO WAY TALK OR LET PEOPLE KNOW IN WHAT ORDER THEY ARE GOING DURING THE CHALLENGE. DISQUALIFICATION WILL RESULT!**
5. Challenges will not be permitted 2 weeks prior to a concert or festival.
6. Failing to appear for a challenge is an automatic disqualification.

Drug & Alcohol Testing... Board Policy #544... "DCSD students who wish to participate in cocurricular... activities are required to submit to random, suspicionless testing or their urine to determine the presence of illicit drugs, alcohol, and other banned substances." A meeting for parents and students new to the music department usually takes place in the early fall. You will only have to attend this meeting once during your high school career.

Freshman & 8th Grade Addendum

Freshman & successful 8th grade auditionees are in a unique situation. Hopefully this addendum will address these circumstances. In November 1993 meeting with the superintendent it was determined that the Frosh band members (this year we are including 8th graders by audition only) of CVMS & PWLMS will be bussed to DHS one day a week during marching season. Since DHS is on block scheduling the bussing will occur during lunch on the 2nd band day of the week. This may be a Wednesday or Thursday (or the rare Friday). The 2011 marching band season concludes in mid-November with the Las Vegas "Sounds Across the Valley"

Band Trip... As a Frosh/8th grade band member, you will be able to participate on any overnight trip the band may take... **ONLY if you have an exemplary attendance record with the DHS Band. Minimum attendance at all rehearsals, DHS Band class, and performances must be 90%. Decision of the DHS Band Director is final.**

Band Performances... You shall perform with the DHS band at ALL marching performances, including the "overnight trips"

Transportation... The same rules apply, except you will be bussed to DHS arriving at 12:10 PM in the band room (one day per week). You may take the bus home from DHS or make other arrangements (except on Wednesdays when after school band practice takes place from 2:30 - 6:30 PM).

Honors Program... Frosh will be able to participate with DHS (sorry no 8th graders). The taping will be done either at your school or DHS. The CVMS & PWLMS Music budgets will pay for your audition and participation fees. For the Solo & Ensemble festival, you may choose to participate with your school or DHS. Only high school students (9-12) may participate at Allstate. Freshman may only participate in the state S & E Festival when it is held in Reno/Carson... or if they have made an Allstate group (band, choir, etc.).

Booster Organization... All Parents of the 8/9 class are encouraged to participate in the organization.

1. Timpani pedals must have the heel down when they are done being used.
2. All mallets must be returned to the proper drawer in the percussion cabinet when they are finished being used.
3. All instruments that have covers must have the covers placed on the instrument when finished.
4. All "toys" must be returned to the percussion cabinet when they are finished being used.
5. The section leader must lock the cabinet when rehearsal is over.
6. Marching percussion may not be "thrown" on the ground!
7. Damage to any equipment (mallets, instruments, carriers, heads, etc.) that is the fault of the player due to negligence or abuse will be repaired by the person who caused the damage. This cost will be the retail cost of the equipment. (The director will determine negligence or abuse.)
8. The director may amend these rules at any time. If they are amended, a copy will be given to you to sign.
